Then if a student believes that their grade does not reflect the standard of their performance they will ask their centre to submit an appeal on their behalf to the exam board. The centre will provide the exam board with the evidence used to determine the student’s grade. Further details on the Appeals process is still to be confirmed by the awarding bodies.
