£4.50 per hour for year 1. Rising to the national minimum wage in the second year.

This apprenticeship is based at our office in Tebay.

We are looking for self-motivated individuals with a strong interest in conservation to work in the beautiful landscape of the Westmorland Dales. We have four apprenticeship opportunities, ideal for enthusiastic individuals who would like to gain the skills necessary for a countryside career in land management or wildlife conservation.

The 'Skills for the Future' project is part of the Westmorland Dales Landscape Partnership Scheme, a programme grant-funded through the National Lottery Heritage Fund; which aims to reveal, conserve and celebrate the hidden heritage of the area that became part of the extended Yorkshire Dales National Park in 2016.
